

## CLEAN UP DAY DONATION UPDATE

**GreenWaste of Palo Alto is excited to announce that clean, gently used furniture will once again be accepted for donation through the residential Clean Up Day program.**

To participate, set out your gently used furniture and label it with "Donate" on your pre-scheduled Clean Up Day. Furniture that our partner donation organizations are seeking include:

- Chairs
- Coffee tables
- Couches
- Dining tables
- Dressers and bookshelves
- Loveseats
- Nightstand and end tables
- Small kitchen appliances (countertop only)

Furniture that meets these specifications will be donated and reused. Broken, stained, or otherwise low-quality furniture may still be set out for collection, however, it will be recycled instead of reused. Drivers are knowledgeable of the donation standards and will determine what can be reused vs recycled.

Additional items accepted for reuse include:

- Clothing and textiles
- Books
- CDs/DVDs (only commercial recordings in original cases and in resale condition; no personal recordings)

Please do not place antiques out for donation through the Clean Up Day program. They can be more appropriately re-homed through other programs such as Freecycle or Nextdoor.
