

CONTAINERS- Debris boxes and bins are available in a variety of sizes for source separated and mixed materials. Containers can be ordered on an on-call basis or as a scheduled weekly service by calling (650) 493-4894.

LOADING CONTAINERS- Sort and separate all construction and deconstruction related materials into designated containers (debris boxes or bins) based on material type. Material must be level and cannot extend higher than the sides of the container or the fill-line.

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS- All debris boxes have a weight limit of 8 tons and all bins have a weight limit of 0.5 tons. If you are loading heavy materials such as concrete, dirt, shingles, or sod, weight restrictions may limit the amount of material you can place into the container.

HAULING- All deconstruction and construction projects are required to utilize GreenWaste of Palo Alto for the collection of all materials if using containers (bins or debris boxes) at project sites.

MATERIAL CATEGORIES - Materials are divided into two categories, Category A and Category B. Service fees are determined based on these categories.



CARTS - Carts are required for deconstruction projects with a minimum project length of 1 month or longer. Service will occur on a weekly basis for three material streams – recycle, compost, and landfill. Carts are designated for material generated during deconstruction activities such as workers' lunches.



RECYCLE: carts available in either 64 or 96 gallon sizes.

COMPOST: carts available in either 64 or 96 gallon sizes.

LANDFILL: carts available in either 64 or 96 gallon sizes.
